



OB Community Cleanup/Recycling Event

Eliminate clutter and get rid of unwanted items by donating or recycling them at the City of San Diego's Community Cleanup/Recycling Event on Saturday, October 13, from 8:00 a.m. to 1:00 p.m., next to Robb Field in Ocean Beach.

This event is designed to help Ocean Beach residents properly dispose of or recycle bulky items that do not fit in the City's refuse collection or curbside recycling containers.

Zero Waste San Diego will be partnering with the Ocean Beach Community Development Committee (CDC), the Ocean Beach Town Council and the City of San Diego Environmental Services Department (ESD) to provide expanded recycling and reuse opportunities for residents of OB.

Help us keep these recyclable and reusable items out of the landfill.

Acceptable Items:

- Reusable appliances
- Carpeting
- Reusable electronics *(such as TVs, computer monitors, VCRs, and CPUs)
- Cell phones and Laser/Inkjet printer cartridges (donations will go to the Point Loma High School Foundation and Alumni Association)
- Furniture
- Lawnmowers (free of oil/gas)
- Metals
- Wood
- Yard trimmings (Grass, leaves, shrub clippings less than four feet long and no one piece more than six inches in diameter, and bundled in lengths no longer than four feet, tied with string on both ends, and weighing no more than 40 pounds)

Unacceptable Items:

- Dirt, construction materials, or demolition rubble
- Light bulbs or tubes
- Household hazardous wastes (paint, batteries, motor oil)
- Tires
