LIVE LOVE BE...GREEN! SAN DIEGO LGBT PRIDE PARADE & FESTIVAL 2008

Thank you for your interest in participating at this year's LGBT Pride. We are not only supporting the LGBT community here and San Diego; we are making one of THE largest Pride events green. Does it get any better than that?

★ Volunteer Job Descriptions:

Parade Volunteer (Sat. 7/19, Hillcrest): Set up the parade with bins, lids, and signage we need for the event along parade route and at each reviewing stand. Monitor bins in designated areas, break down bins and clean up after event.

Festival Set Up/Monitor (Sat. 7/19, Marston Point, Balboa Park): Set up the festival with bins, lids, and signage we need for the event. *To do this, you must also commit to Saturday's Shift 1: 10:30am – 4:30pm.

Exhibitor/Vendor Liaison (Sat 7/19, Sun 7/20): Work with exhibitors and vendors to create the most diversion possible. Also, help break down cardboard boxes and move them to the roll-offs, and notify exhibitors and vendors where paper/cardboard only bins are located.

Recycling Monitor (Sat 7/19, Sun 7/20): In designated area, monitor bins, change out liners to prevent overflow, answer questions about recycling at the event, move recyclables from trash to recycling bins. *Notify in your response if you can show proof of being 21+. There is a chance you might be placed in a beverage garden area...don't get too excited, no drinking on the job!

Supervisor (Sat 7/19, Sun 7/20): Oversee larger designated areas, provide assistance to monitors, act as liaison between monitors and coordinators, monitor inventory needs. Must be 21+.

★ Perks:

Free entry into the Festival for the duration of your shift and a meal, plus all the water and snacks you'd like!

★ Time Commitment:

Mandatory Volunteer Training

Saturday, July 12 – San Diego Pride is having a mandatory volunteer training session at 12pm at The Center in Hillcrest. Afterwards, Zero Waste San Diego will be going over our specific details for Pride. Please bring a white t-shirt to the mandatory volunteer training, as we will all be decorating our t-shirts together.

Saturday, July 19 - Shift 1: 10:30am – 4:30pm, Shift 2: 4:30pm – 10:30pm

Sunday, July 20 – Shift 1: 10:30am – 3:30pm, Shift 2: 3:30pm – 8:30pm

Arrival

Five minutes before your scheduled volunteer time, check in at Recycling Headquarters located at the Exhibitor Relations booth at the Juniper entrance of Balboa Park. A Recycling Coordinator will give you instructions from there.

★ Attire:

Be ready to get dirty! We recommend jeans/shorts you don't mind getting dirty, and comfortable, closed-toe shoes, please no sandals! You will be required to wear the t-shirt we've made for the entire duration of your shift and will not be let in to volunteer without it! If you have gloves please bring them; if not, notify us and we will provide latex gloves to you. Also we recommend a hat, sunglasses, and sunscreen for your protection!
